### Construction Update



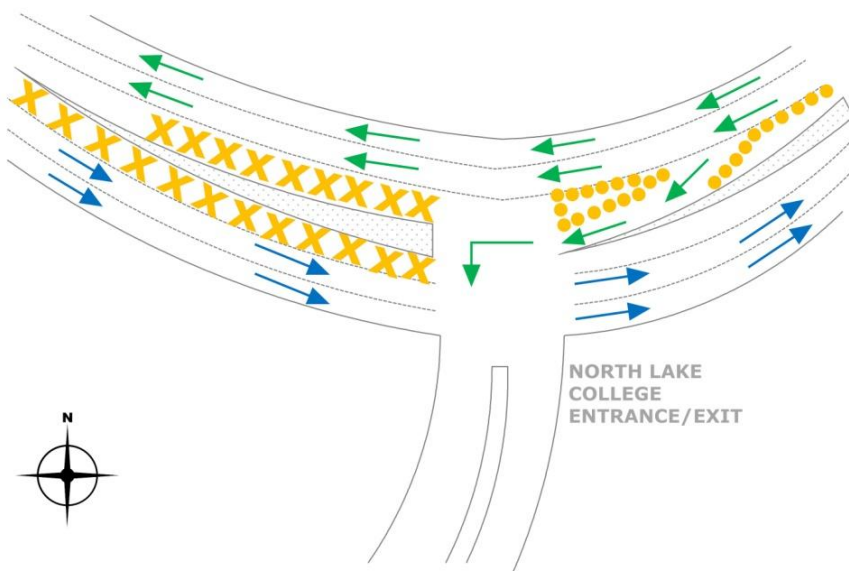
The DART Orange Line construction is quickly moving along the corridor and into the North Lake College area. Construction activities will be in preparation for the light rail system that will extend from downtown Dallas, through Las Colinas, and eventually connect to the DFW airport. Currently, construction activities in this area include utility relocations and bridge structure work that may require traffic impacts to MacArthur Blvd and the entrance to North Lake College. In an attempt to minimize these traffic impacts, some night work may be required.

Utility relocations and bridge structure activities will be on-going for the next few months.

In an attempt to minimize impacts, weekly construction updates are emailed out. This helps provide a more definitive answer to many construction questions, and provides notice to areas that may experience upcoming traffic delays or construction activity.

*Beginning February 3, the inside median lanes of northbound and southbound MacArthur will be restricted to provide a safe work area as crews complete drill shaft operations. These lane restrictions will remain in place for a few months as crews complete the bridge substructure operations. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction and access to North Lake College will remain open. Please note that all dates are tentative as they do not account for weather delays or other schedule impacts.*



Beginning **February 3**, lane restrictions of the inside, median lanes of northbound and southbound MacArthur will be required for crews to complete drill shaft operations. These restrictions will remain in place for a few months.

For your safety, please use caution when traveling through construction zones, obey any changes to speed limits or detours, and be aware of the workers delivering the project.
